Wisconsin (Secretary of Agriculture Declarations – Drought Incidents, includes "Low Snow" & "Lack of Snow")

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Secretary of Agriculture Declarations (Sec-Ag)

If the Secretary of Agriculture designates an area an agricultural disaster, SBA automatically activates its Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) program for farm related and non-farm related businesses.

Loans are made available to eligible small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives and private nonprofit organizations that have suffered substantial economic injury as a result of the declared disaster.

Loans are not available to agricultural enterprises, except in declarations for drought.

Nurseries are eligible to apply.

The filing deadline is **July 31, 2024**. In Door County the deadline is **September 26, 2024**.





Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDLs)



Loan Terms:

- Up to **30 years**, based on ability to repay
- Low-Fixed interest rate 4%
- No monthly payments or interest for the first year



Working capital loans for both farm related and nonfarm related businesses



Hotels, restaurants, ski and snowmobile rentals, sleigh rides, snowboard manufacturers, and snow removal services.



Maximum loan amount is \$2,000,000



Help meet working capital needs caused by the low snow, lack of snow




EIDLs do not replace lost revenue, lost profits or fund expansion

SBA Disaster Loans are Different from SBA Guaranteed Loans



- SBA's Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDLs) funds come directly from the U.S. Treasury
- Applicants do not go through a bank to apply. Instead apply directly to SBA's Disaster Assistance Program at: <u>sba.gov/Disaster</u>
- There is no cost to apply
- There is no obligation to take the loan if offered
- Applicants can have an existing SBA Disaster Loan and still qualify for a loan for this disaster, but the loans cannot be consolidated
- Filing deadline is September 26, 2024 in Door County; for ALL other Wisconsin Counties, the deadline is July 31, 2024



Requirements for Loan Approvals



Eligibility

• Damaged property must be in a declared area.



Credit History

• Applicants must have a credit history acceptable to SBA.



Repayment

• Applicants must show the ability to repay all loans.

Collateral Requirements

- Economic injury disaster loans over \$25,000 require collateral.
 - SBA takes real estate as collateral when it is available.
 - SBA will not decline a loan for lack of collateral but will require the borrower to pledge collateral that is available.




By going to Lending.sba.gov, Applicants can apply for SBA disaster loans.




The page provides the map of the declared area, access to the fact sheet and locations to receive assistance.





What Is Needed To Apply for a Business Loan?

- Cell Phone Number & Contact Information for all applicants
- Social Security Numbers and Employer ID Numbers (EIN) for all owners
- Financial Information: income, account balances, monthly expenses, etc.
- Complete copy of the most recent Federal Income Tax Return
- Insurance Information, if available







Tips

- Legal name, ID, etc. as appears on the federal tax filing
- Multiple Log In Attempts
- Password Reset (Photo of Username and password)
- Multiple owners Joint application
- Notifications How to ensure you stay in the know
 - Monitor the Portal and your email two to three times a day
 - Check your Spam folder




Understanding Service Requests

Applicants can click on "Complete Request" for required and upcoming requests to complete them.








Personal Financial Statements

*This service request is by owner/individual.






Schedule of Liabilities

Applicants provide the details below for each fixed debt/creditor they have






Document Requests

The applicant will need to access their portal, open the "Action" button to see what is being requested. They can upload the document and provide additional information before submitting.





*All document requests have an "unable to provide" option. If selected, the applicant must provide a brief explanation of why is not available.
